The PHIL BATES SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS 2010-2011

The Southern California Section of the Institute of Food Technologists (SCIFTS) will offer scholarships for the 2010-2011 academic year. The awards will provide financial assistance to **High School, Undergraduate and Graduate Students** who are attending or planning to attend a college or university in the SCIFTS geographical area (Southern California) majoring in Food Science.

\$1000 (minimum) grants will be awarded to qualified students who are attending any college or university and are working toward a degree in food technology, food science, and nutrition or in a related field.

Scholarship awards will be given to graduate and undergraduate students attending both IFT and non-IFT approved programs.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: MARCH 5, 2010

Scholarship recipients will be notified in June and the awards presented in October 2010 after the awardee submits verification of satisfactory completion of the '09-10 academic year's work and registration for the Fall 2010 term.

IN ORDER TO QUALIFY, THE APPLICANT MUST HAVE A CUMULATIVE GPA OF 3.0 (ON A 4-POINT SCALE) OR BETTER AND SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING TO THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE FOR CONSIDERATION:

HIGH SCHOOL

- Five copies of a 1-2 page personal statement to include:
 - Educational goals/15 points
 - Employment goal/10 points
 - Financial need/10 points
 - Overall write-up/5 points

(40 points max)
- Five copies of current resume to include:
 - Academic history
 - Employment history
 - Clubs and positions held
 - Charity and organizations

(20 points max)
- One official transcript of academic records:
GPA > 3.7 (30 points)
3.3-3.69 (20 points)
3.0-3.29 (10 points)
- Two letters of recommendation (5 copies each), sealed in an envelope from academic or food industry professionals, to be separately mailed to and received by the Scholarship Committee before the application deadline.

(10 points max)

UNDERGRADUATE and GRADUATE

- Five copies of a 1-2 page personal statement to include:
 - Current research, if applicable
 - Educational and Employment goals
 - Financial need
 - Grammar, clarity and organization

(25 points max)
- Five copies of current resume to include:
 - Academic history
 - Employment history
 - Honors and awards
 - Professional organizations and positions held
 - Charity and other organizational participation

(25 points max)
- One official transcript of all undergraduate and/or graduate academic records (as applicable):
GPA > 3.7 (25 points)
3.3-3.69 (15 points)
3.0-3.29 (10 points)
- Five copies of Professional Activities e.g. IFT and SCIFTS involvement.

(15 points max)
- Two letters of recommendation (5 copies each), sealed in an envelope from academic or food industry professionals, to be separately mailed to and received by the Scholarship Committee before the application deadline.

(10 points max)
